Application Customization Stockpile Dressta's crawler dozers have a stockpile compaction feature package that has been built to manage tricky job situations including sloped and unstable work environments. A reinforced Dressta steel drum is one of the main pieces of equipment for the SFR equipment complete with a winch line attachment consisting of brackets connecting to the drum. There is a tensioning apparatus that prevents the line from coming into contact with the slope face. These crawler dozers evenly distribute their weight to ensure stability and balance.

Fire Tractor Dozers The Dressta fire tractor dozers are an excellent defense in forest fire work in terms of prevention, containment and cleaning up forest fires. These units are perfect for working around heavy ash, fallen trees, burning sap, dirt and airborne sand. Fire crews utilize this equipment for clearing paths, establishing fire lines and removing combustible items. Fire suppression equipment includes external sensors, nozzles and an onboard control unit. A forestry cab kit helps to protect the operator and the machine with guards, steel mesh screens, sweeps and metallic fire curtains to eliminate damage from trees that fall during the fire. The electrical components inside the tractor are protected by fire-resistant sheeting, while heavy-duty guards protect hoses and hydraulic cylinders. Special features are implemented to prevent overheating such as cooling modules for the powertrain, charge air and radiator and the direct drive powertrain. Belt Shifting Conveyor belts are used by mining applications to transport debris and minerals from the seam where they are found to different locations for reprocessing. The SB-85 Dressta model is commonly used for rapidly repositioning and realigning conveyor belts on the job site. This model can be used to shift railway tracks with a belt width up to 2500mm or is equally useful in confined spaces. Its high ground clearance keeps it mobile along difficult terrain.
